The Manitoba School for the Deaf (MSD) is coordinating the Challenge for Credit Option in ASL. High school credits are granted based on competency criteria. The evaluation is conducted once every year at the Manitoba School for the Deaf.

Please note the following information and provide it to interested students:

- Evaluations are generally designed for people who have had extensive exposure to ASL or have developed skills through sign language courses.
- There is no charge for this evaluation.
- Criteria for ASL credits 12G, 22G, 32G, and 42G are available upon request.
